### **Criteria & Policy Guidelines**

#### Examples of financial allocations (including but not limited to):

- 1. Tuition assistance
- 2. Purchase of educational books and resources
- 3. Special ministry educational opportunities (e.g. webinars, seminars, etc.)
- 4. Specialized ministerial training (e.g. youth ministry, interim ministry, etc.)
- 5. Criminal background checks
- 6. Boundary Training through the Michigan Conference
- 7. Support for attending Association, Conference or National setting events (e.g. Synod)

#### **Scholarship Eligibility**

- 1. Applicant must be a member of a Covenant Association church
- 2. Applicant must be a Member in Discernment (MID) with the Covenant Association
- 3. Preference given to first-time applicants
- 4. Grants awarded based on need, merit and funds available at time of application.
- 5. Requested funds must meet approved allocations for use and:
  - a. Must be consistent with the biblical and theological principles and vision of the Covenant Association, Michigan Conference and the United Church of Christ.
  - b. Must provide ministerial vocational development through educational programs and other opportunities
  - c. Recipients are expected to provide a written report regarding the impact of the funding by the end of the fiscal year in which the funds are disbursed (Dec. 31)
